

MAN-IMAL Master's Internship

Calendar and Internship Duration:

- Internship subjects should be submitted from May 1st till mid-november via email to: contact.manimal@oniris-nantes.fr or by postal service to: Formation MANIMAL, Oniris, Site de la Chantrerie, CS 40706, 44307 Nantes Cedex 3
- **Duration: 5 to 6 months** – from April to September (maximum duration permitted is 6 months)

Objectives:

Work placement within a business/structure/laboratory whereby the student must carry out a project, conduct research, or resolve a problem by implementing a scientific approach.

Under the guidance of an internship Supervisor, the student must:

- Formulate a problem or subject in a real context, position it within the context, and if possible, apply it to the different, appropriate levels (socio-economic, scientific, etc.).
- Define objectives, create and implement a working method.
- Exploit the obtained results so as to propose response elements and potential prospects.

Implementing this project within the business/structure/laboratory will allow for the intern to discover the structure's mode of operation and to execute associated, professional responsibilities.

For example, the intern may complete a thorough research project on a specific subject (bibliographical summary, definition of objectives and protocol, study implementation, results exploitation), or participate in a specific phase of a larger project (methodology enhancement, feasibility study, data collection and initial analysis, exploitation of existing data). Research projects must be thoroughly developed and cannot be reduced to a bibliographic study.

Type of Business/Structure/Laboratory: private or public

Student Supervision:

All interns must be assigned a Supervisor who will be responsible for the intern's integration within the structure, defining objectives regarding the expected work to be completed, and overall supervision of the in situ work conducted.

A Director, either a Research Professor or Researcher from one of the Master's academic partners, will be responsible for monitoring the scientific procedure applied to the chosen subject/project. The Director is responsible for the authorization of the student's thesis defense. Decisions are based upon the quality of the Master's thesis.

Internship Conditions:

During the internship period, all interns remain enrolled students at Oniris. According to French law 2006-396 article 9, all interns must be remunerated for their work by the business/structure/laboratory. In addition to the remuneration, other benefits are also permitted (free meals, housing...). The company/structure/laboratory shall provide the intern with all the financial, technical and human resources necessary for the proper execution of the intern's subject/project. An Internship Agreement shall be established between the business/structure/laboratory and the academic partner.

Work Carried Out Will Be Subject To:

- A Master's thesis, no longer than 60 pages, which will be submitted to the student's internship Director at least 3 weeks before the oral presentation.
- An oral presentation before a jury in which the internship Supervisor may participate.

All work completed by the intern will be graded based upon a rating scale (work and behaviour during the internship, thesis and oral presentation quality). This grade represents 50% of the student's overall evaluation necessary to obtain their degree. Validation of teaching experience or scientific publications is possible, with the approval of the contracting parties.

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
